ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

- Applicant must be a resident of the Westran or Higbee School District.
- Applicant must have obtained a high school diploma or a G.E.D.
- The scholarship is available to persons of all ages for vocational, trade, or college, with a preference for, but not limited to, nursing students and adults returning to school after being in the work force.
- Undergraduate and graduate students are eligible to apply.
- Full-time and part-time students are eligible to apply.

Eligibility guidelines are pursuant to such rules and requirements as The Living Memorial Scholarship Board may devise, establish, adopt, and amend from time to time. Scholarships are awarded on the availability of money.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Application for the fall semester must be postmarked by **August 31**; for the spring semester, **December 31**, and for the summer session, **May 31**. Late applications will **not** be considered.
- First-time applicants with college hours, enclose previous college transcript. First-time applicants with no college hours, enclose copy of high school transcript/G.E.D. certificate. Renewal applicants, enclose current transcript or official grade sheet.
- Enclose proof of enrollment for semester for which you are applying.
- Any false or misleading information in the application will automatically disqualify the application from further consideration.
- Incomplete applications will **not** be considered.
